Under 11 Information Sheet 2013/14 – North Cronulla SLSC

Birth Date Falls Between: 01/10/2002 to 30/09/2003

- Parents/Carers **MUST** be with their child at ALL times
- Children are encouraged to carry their own bag with them; this should include Towel, Drink Bottle, Goggles & extra Sunscreen.
- All children must sign **ON** before 8.45am each Sunday morning & sign **OFF** at the finish each day. You must advise your Squad Leader if leaving early.
- Children are to wear their Squad Cap during Nippers; these identify which age group they are in. The cap **MUST** be removed at the completion of Nippers

Under 11 = Sky Blue

- It is advised that the children wear a Rash Shirt (optional) whilst at Nippers & that Sunscreen is applied prior to the start of Nippers.
- During events on the Beach it is requested that parents assist the squad leaders when asked. (*Parent helpers MUST be financial club members*)
- SLSA have minimum requirements for Nippers' proficiency. At North Cronulla, Nippers will not be able to compete in the ocean, unless they successfully undertake a timed pool swim (200M in 5 minutes). Nippers achieving this level (Pool Swim) will also need to complete an "Open Water Swim" to qualify to compete at carnivals.
- **This age group uses Fibre-glass Boards; they cost \$1000 each, so we ask that care be taken when carrying them to the beach & during use. Please make sure they are returned to the Gear Shed after Nippers.**

DEVELOPMENT CAMP:

- Each year, selected U11 children participate in an age Development Camp conducted by Surf Life Saving Sydney. Children are selected for these camps **not** on their ability but on their attitude. Age managers look at their approach, enthusiasm, willingness to be part of a team, participation, attendance and other positive attributes. The U11 camp is at the beginning of February. The camp is held at Deer Park in the Royal National Park.

COMPETITION:

- Nipper Club Championship - Point-score events will be held at North Cronulla for this age group, these events include Beach Sprint, Beach Flags, Surf Swim, Board & Iron-person. Children **MUST** have **100%** attendance to qualify for these events
- This age group can experience Competition if desired at outside Carnivals. It is not compulsory, but the Club does encourage attendance. The events available for the Under 11's & 12's include Beach Sprint, Beach Flags, Surf Swim, Board, Iron-person. There are also team events such as Beach Sprint Relays, Surf Teams, Board Rescue, Board Relay & 2 Person R & R available (Teams will be selected by the Team Manager) **CLUB COSTUME AND COMPETITION CAP MUST BE WORN AT ALL CARNIVALS**
- Branch & State Carnivals are invitation events & persons are chosen by the Team Manager & Selection Committee
- North Cronulla SLSC will give the children education regarding Water & the Surf; however it is the Parents' responsibility to have their child taught to swim.

PHOTOS:

- If wishing to take photos of your child, PLEASE advise the Squad Leaders & other parents within the group prior to doing so. If you notice someone taking photos who shouldn't be, please notify your Squad Leader, a Committee Member &/or a Patrol Person.

BBQ DUTY AND BEACH SET UP AND BEACH PULL DOWN

- There will be **ONE** day during the season when your Age Group will be rostered on to do **COMPULSORY** duty to assist with the smooth running of Club. Duties included "Beach Set Up/Close Down", "BBQ Duties" & "Clean Up". Age managers will advise of your responsibilities, so please assist your Squad & work together to make the day successful.
